Terms for the use of open geographical data

### **General information**

The Danish Agency for Data Supply and Infrastructure, hereinafter the Agency, has the intellectual property rights to the open geographical data (hereinafter data), and grants the right to use the data under the following conditions.

The conditions apply to all use of the data.

The conditions are governed by Danish law.

### **Right of use**

The Agency provides a worldwide, free, non-exclusive, and otherwise unlimited right of use to the data, which may freely :

be copied, distributed and published,  
modified and merged with other material  
used commercially or non-commercially,

### **Terms**

The data may not be used in such a way that it appears as if the Agency approves, supports, recommends

or markets the user, the user's products or the user's services.

It must be ensured that use of the data is in accordance with Danish law.

### **Source citation**

The Agency maintains its copyright. When data is used, the user must:  
in a reasonable place suitable for the distribution medium insert the following:

- "Contains data from the Danish Agency for Data Supply and Infrastructure"
- The name of the data set(s)
- Time when the data set(s) were retrieved from the Agency, or whether they are from a data service.

(eg: "Contains data from the Danish Agency for Data Supply and Infrastructure, Denmark's Elevation Model, January 2016". Or: "Contains data from the Danish Agency for Data Supply and Infrastructure, Skærmkortet, WMS service")

- ensure that "The Danish Agency for Data Supply and Infrastructure" appears on the landing page of the service, if other sources are also mentioned on the landing page
- make a copy of these terms (possibly via a link) available to third parties

The above terms and conditions also apply if the user passes on data from the Agency to third parties.

### **The Agency's rights and responsibilities**

The data is provided as is and the Agency has no responsibility for any content, origin, errors or

omissions or any damage that may result from the use of the data.

The Agency does not guarantee the continued provision of data.

The Agency may at any time change the rights to use the data and the terms thereof. Data already

downloaded when the new terms come into force can continue to be used on the hitherto applicable terms. If the data used is updated or merged with new data from the Agency, made available on new terms, then the new terms apply to all the data.

**Personal data in the Agency's data**

The Agency's data may contain personal data, or may, when put together with other data sets, constitute personal data. To the extent that data with or without such compilation constitutes personal data, the user is responsible for complying with the Data Protection Regulation and other legislation when using these data.
