

Military land use DK dataset

This dataset contains geographical delineation of 113 current and former (as of 2017) defence sites in Denmark including information about the land use development and time of military use on each site. The data is available as an ESRI shapefile in UTM ETRS89 32N projection with attribute values.

This dataset is a result of a research project “Military land use history” funded by the Danish Ministry of Defence Estate Agency (MDEA).

Source: Source of information (values: 1cm map=topographic map in 1:100.000, Basic Cover 1954=1:10.000 aerial photographs from 1954, DDOland 1995 =aerial photographs 1995, FSV1974=map from ministry of defence 1974, FSV2017=spatial data from Danish Defence 2017).

Da_start_t: Year of first military activity at defence site

GE_start_t: year of German military use
